Information obligations according to the General Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO) for visitors during the corona pandemic

acc. Art. 13 DSGVO Description of the processing activity Collection and storage of names, addresses and telephone numbers

Purpose and legal basis of the processing Your data will be processed for the purpose of tracing chains of infection on the basis of Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Letter c) GDPR. **Recipients of personal data** in the event of infection on the day of your visit, your data will be passed on to the responsible health department, which will inform you about how to proceed. Duration of storage of personal data The data collected from you (first and last name, address and telephone number) will be stored for four weeks and then destroyed in our company. Rights of data subjects According to the EU General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights: If your personal data are processed, you have the right to rectification. (Art 16 DSGVO). If the legal requirements are met, you can request the deletion or restriction of processing and if there is an objection to data processing and data processing is carried out using automated procedures, you may have the right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR). If you make use of your above-mentioned rights, the business owner will check whether the legal requirements for this have been met.
